Words cannot express our sorrow surrounding the devastating flooding that occurred in our beautiful Valley communities on May 27. While our Ellicott City office was impacted minimally, many of our neighbors and personal acquaintances suffered greatly. We are heartbroken for those who lost so much. As communities and leaders continue to grapple with the consequences of this latest disaster we will remain cognizant of our mission. As work continues toward finding solutions to both prevent and mitigate future loss of life and property, PHG is committed to helping in all ways possible to ensure that the history and environment of the Patapsco Valley is preserved. To help with the immediate needs facing many we have donated \$10,000 toward flood relief efforts in Catonsville, Ellicott City and Patapsco Valley State Park. We have also conducted the following cleanup efforts since the flooding:

- 57 volunteers cleared Avalon picnic area and removed debris
- 28 volunteers collected 1,630 pounds of trash during cleanup of Miller Run
- 39 volunteers collected 2,690 pounds of trash during cleanup at Cycle Mill
- 31 volunteers spread mulch, removed debris & repaired fencing at Avalon
- 10 volunteers collected 1,080 pounds of trash during second Avalon cleanup

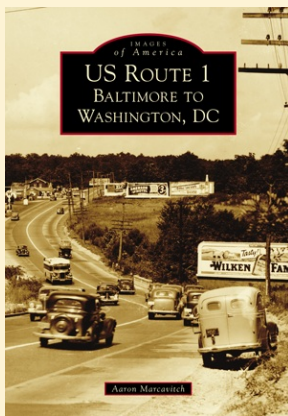

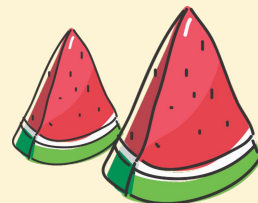
SAVE THE DATE : September 12 *PHG Annual Membership Meeting with special guest author presentation at HCLS Elkridge Branch*
