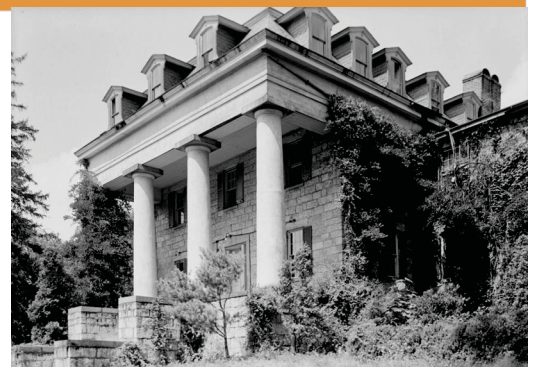




# Creating Change in the 20th Century
